## 2026 Legislative Session

### BILL DESCRIPTIONS



#### Pensions

##### **SSB 5862 – TRS/PERS 1 one-time COLA**

Provides a one-time 3% cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) with a \$110/mo cap for PERS & TRS 1 retirees, effective July 1, 2026.

##### **HB 2124 – Lump sum retirement payments**

Raises the amount of a retirement benefit that can be paid as a one-time lump sum instead of monthly payments.



#### Voting Rights

##### **E3SHB 1710 – Voting Rights Act compliance**

Strengthens the Washington Voting Rights Act by requiring "preclearance" for changes to local election systems. This is to prevent discrimination in elections.

##### **E2SHB 1750 – Voting Rights Act claims**

Defines how courts should evaluate claims that election systems unfairly reduce the voting power of certain communities.

##### **ESHB 1916 – Voter registrations**

Tightens the rules for challenging voter registrations in Washington state to prevent frivolous or mass challenges. Updates how the state cleans and maintains voter registration lists.



#### Taxes

##### **ESSB 6162 – Property tax**

Makes changes to Washington's property tax system, such as how taxes are calculated or limited.



#### Healthcare

##### **ESHB 2242 – Preventive health services**

Ensures that Washingtonians continue to have access to preventive health services—such as vaccines, cancer screenings, and well-child visits—with no out-of-pocket costs.

##### **E2SSB 5395 – Prior authorization/health**

Requires health insurers to be more transparent and timely when deciding whether to approve or deny medical treatments that need prior authorization.

##### **SB 5915 – Health technology assessment**

Changes how Washington reviews medical treatments and technologies to decide what should be covered by public health programs.

##### **E2SSB 5981 – 340B drug pricing program**

Protects access to discounted medications for hospitals and clinics by preventing drug companies from limiting participation in the federal 340B program.

##### **SJM 8002 - Medicare**

Filed with the Secretary of State. This bill is a resolution to the U.S. President, Congress, and Sec. of Health & Human Services urging Congress to preserve Medicare funding and level the playing field by expanding benefits like those found in Medicare Advantage plans - such as dental, vision, and hearing.
