Re: 2022 RPEC Convention COVID Protocols

To minimize risk to fellow delegates, guests, and staff, RPEC has established the following protocols to be followed throughout our convention, Tuesday, September 27th through Thursday, September 29th. All delegates, alternates, and guests are asked to review this list prior to your arrival.

1. All attendees are advised to test and confirm a negative COVID result within 24 hours prior to arriving. Additionally, RPEC will provide each attendee with a COVID rapid antigen test kit at registration to continue testing over the duration of convention.
2. All attendees will attest to both a negative COVID test and that they are free of COVID symptoms before receiving credentials at registration.
3. All attendees should familiarize themselves with the symptoms of COVID, and RPEC will post CDC guidance at all convention entry points.
4. Attendees experiencing COVID symptoms and/or testing positive are asked to isolate in their room.
5. All attendees are required to wear N95 or KN95 masks in all in-door gathering spaces. **Cloth masks are not permitted.**
6. Masks should be properly fitted for the best protection against COVID. RPEC will have N95 and KN95 masks available for attendees at registration and in the convention office.
7. RPEC will make hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes available in all convention gathering spaces.
8. Attendees are encouraged to have a clearly marked personal water bottle and be cautious of potential cross contamination at water stations.
9. Attendees are asked to report any symptoms or a positive COVID result to RPEC Staff immediately. **Call or text Derek @ 360-259-3031.**
10. Attendees should have a contingency plan in place to isolate or return home should you test positive or develop symptoms.

Your health and safety remains our top priority and we ask that you please be mindful of your fellow members and stay home and/or isolate if you are feeling sick.
