Descriptions:

1. Elections Committee

- a. The Elections Committee utilizes the AFSCME Retiree Election manual, the RPEC Constitution and any RPEC rules to oversee elections during Convention. They also may make amendments to such and recommend those to the body of the Convention prior to the body voting to accept the Election Rules to govern the elections.
- b. The Elections Committee oversees the Executive Officer (President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer) elections held during Convention, as well as the District Board member caucuses/elections.
- c. The Election Committee reports the results of all elections to the Convention body.

2. Legislative Committee

- a. The Legislative Committee reviews, makes any amendments to and makes recommendations to the Convention body on the State & Federal Legislative Priorities forwarded to them from the Standing Legislative Committee that acts under the Executive Board between conventions.
- b. The Legislative Committee also reviews, makes amendments to and makes recommendation to the Convention body on any submitted resolution(s) that requests/requires legislative action.

3. Resolutions Committee

- a. The Resolutions Committee reviews, makes amendments to and makes recommendation to the Convention body on any submitted non- legislative resolution(s).

4. Constitution Committee

- a. The Constitution Committee reviews, makes amendments to and makes recommendation to the Convention body on any submitted Constitutional Amendments.

5. Convention Rules Committee

- a. The Convention Rules Committee reviews, makes amendments to and makes recommendation to the Convention body on the Proposed Rules and Order of Business which govern the structure of the convention meeting. Rules and Order of Business are acted upon by the Convention body following the adoption of the agenda.

6. Sergeant-at-arms Committee

- a. The Sergeant-at-arms Committee is responsible for monitoring the doors in the general session meeting room, ensuring alternates and guests are seated in assigned sections, calling the body back to session when on break, passing out handouts, counting votes cast by show of hands (if needed), and maintaining the decorum of the meeting.

7. Registration Committee

- a. The Registration Committee is responsible for registering delegates, alternates and guests, handing out convention packets and badges, and handing out goodie bags. The Committee makes a report to the convention body each morning of session.

8. RPEC PAC Raffle Committee

- a. The RPEC PAC Raffle Committee is responsible for setting up the raffle room, assigning tags and inventory for each item donated, selling raffle tickets, drawing the winners for each item and handing off items to winners.
